Subject: UCB 340B Contract Pharmacy Policy

May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024

Dear 340B Covered Entity,

I am writing in follow-up to our previous communication on Sept 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023. UCB supports the goals of the 340B program to help underserved populations and continues to comply with its obligations under that program to offer drugs at 340B prices to covered entities to ensure that they have access to products at the discounted price in support of their service to 340B program patients.

In light of the recent Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals ruling in PhRMA v. McClain, UCB will not apply its 340B Contract Pharmacy Policy to 340B covered entities in Arkansas. Beginning June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, for 340B eligible patients, Arkansas covered entities will be able to order products and/or place “Bill to/Ship to” replenishment orders through any Arkansas-based community pharmacy with which they have a 340B drug pricing contract pharmacy arrangement.
